



## Getting to the event by car

Although there's no visitor parking at or near the College, getting to the event by car is as easy as 1, 2, 3...

**1: Park in one of the East Hampshire District Council (EHDC) car parks in Alton Town Centre that are listed below.**

- All the Car Parks are signposted and the Address, Postcode and What 3 Words address is given below.
- Check the tariff board in the car park for the current parking charges and charging times in case they've changed.
- Disabled and Motorcycles are free in EHDC car parks (check the tariff board in the car park in case this has changed).
- If you need to pay the payment can be made using coins or cards at the ticket machine or by using RingGo.
- Make a note of which car park you have parked in or take a photo of the tariff board to remind you.
- Please don't attempt to park in the roads surrounding the College as it will annoy the residents and may obstruct or delay traffic including the very buses you've come to see and ride on.

**2: Either walk to the College or walk to one of the bus stops listed below to catch the free bus to the College.**

- Catch any number 254 or 554 bus from one of the bus stops listed below to go to the College.
- Buses run approximately every 10 minutes. **First bus: 09:35\*. Last bus: 15:40\***. \*Times from High Street (Stop B) and a few minutes later from other bus stops.
- Some journeys will be operated by low floor wheelchair accessible buses (see timetable for details).
- *Please note: There is very limited space on the buses for pushchairs. Pushchairs may only be carried if there is storage space available and they must be folded before boarding.*

**3: When it's time to go home or if you need to go back to your car during the day either walk to the car park or catch the free bus from the College.**

- Catch any number 254 or 554 bus from Bus Stand B at the College.
- Buses run approximately every 10 minutes. **First bus: 10:05. Last bus: 16:20.**
- Some journeys will be operated by low floor wheelchair accessible buses (see timetable for details).
- *Please note: There is very limited space on the buses for pushchairs. Pushchairs may only be carried if there is storage space available and they must be folded before boarding.*

### Travelling on the Watercress Line?

If you plan to also travel on the Watercress Line you may prefer to park in Alton Station car park. See last page for more details.

**Visitor access to the College (pedestrians and pedal cyclists only) is through the Old Odiham Road gate.**

**There is no visitor access to the College through the Edward Road and Linnets Way gates.**

**There is no car parking at or near the College. Use town centre car parks and free bus service.**

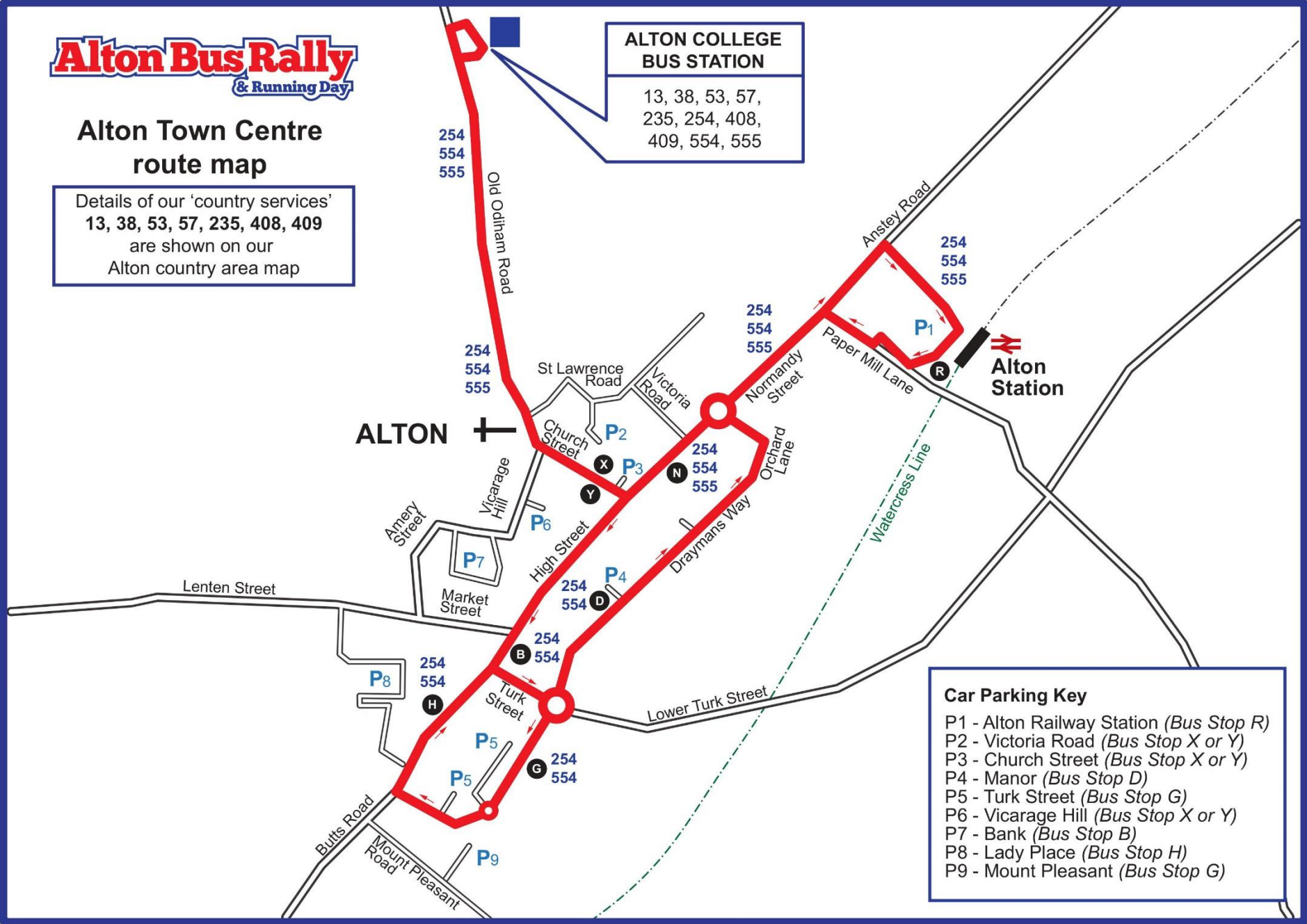

# Travelling on the Watercress Line?

If you plan to also travel on the Watercress Line you may prefer to park in Alton Station car park.

**1: Park in one of the car parks at Alton Railway Station that are listed below.**

**Main station car park (operated by South Western Railway)** has 207 spaces (including 5 disabled spaces) and no height restriction.

Parking price on Sundays (check tariff board): £5.10 all day.

Payment can be made using cash or cards at the self-service ticket machine at the station or by RingGo.

Address: Alton Station, Station Road, Alton, GU34 2PZ.

Walking Distance / Time to College: 0.7 mile / 20 min

**Additional station car park (operated by SiP)** has 80 spaces. Height restriction 2.1m.

Parking price on Sundays (check tariff board): £2.00 for up to 12 hours.

Payment can be made by card at the ticket machine or by phone or online.

**2: Either walk to the College or walk to Alton Station bus stop 'R' (near the station entrance) to catch the free bus to the College.**

- Catch any number 254, 554 or 555 bus from Alton Station (Bus Stop R) to go to the College.
- Buses run approximately every 10 minutes. **First bus: 09:39. Last bus: 15:50.**
- Some journeys will be operated by low floor wheelchair accessible buses (see timetable for details).
- *Please note: There is very limited space on the buses for pushchairs. Pushchairs may only be carried if there is storage space available and they must be folded before boarding.*

**3: When it's time to go home or if you need to go back to your car during the day either walk to the car park or catch the free bus from the College.**

- Catch any number 254 or 554 bus from Bus Stand B at the College.
- Buses run approximately every 10 minutes. **First bus: 10:05. Last bus: 16:20.**
